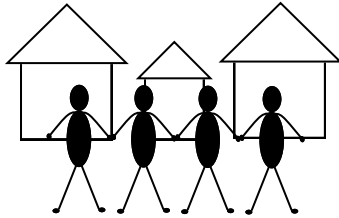


Interested in Becoming a Member?

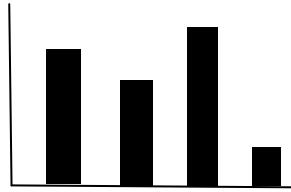

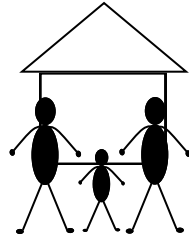


How do we serve the community?

Data



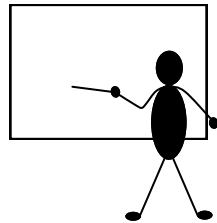
The Coalition seeks to collect and maintain quality local data on homelessness in order to support the need for funding of housing programs and other services for the homeless in Lebanon County.



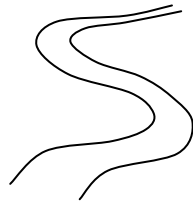
Housing

We aim to address the lack of quality, affordable housing in Lebanon County. We seek out housing programs and other opportunities to decrease homelessness.

Education



We strive to educate the community about people who experience homelessness, sensitize the community about homelessness, and to destroy myths about homelessness.



Transportation

The Coalition intends to seek out opportunities to address transportation in Lebanon County, especially for individuals who are unable to work due to barriers to accessing transportation.

Who we are:

The Lebanon County Coalition to End Homelessness was established in 1990 as a response to the Second Century Initiative Committee of the United Way. It began through a research project to determine how the United Way could best address the need for action to solve the problem: "Investigate housing difficulties in Lebanon County as it relates to temporary homelessness and the possible solutions involving the United Way." The Coalition continues today independently of the United Way but with the same purpose.
