



Lebanon County Coalition to End Homelessness Youth Fund Guidelines

LCCEH Youth Funds are available for youth experiencing homelessness with needs that cannot be met by other community resources.

Eligibility

Youth up to 24 years old who are lacking a fixed, regular, or adequate nighttime residence. This includes youth who are:

- Sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason.
- Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camp grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations.
- Living in emergency or transitional shelters.
- Living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, or similar settings.
- Migratory children living in one of the above circumstances.

Referral Process

- Referrals must be made by an appropriate school or agency official via the LCCEH request form.
- Completed forms will be emailed to LCCEH at lccteh1@gmail.com.
- All requests will be approved by the LCCEH Executive Committee and funds will be made available as soon as possible.
- Individuals are eligible to receive up to \$50 maximum.
- Referrals for the youth fund should be made after other community resources are exhausted.
