VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!

WHAT: Volunteers are needed to count and survey homeless persons living on the streets within their communities. Volunteers must attend a training session where they will receive instructions on conducting the count and on important safety guidelines.

WHEN: The count and survey will take place on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 between 9:00 p.m. - Midnight. Training begins at 8:00 p.m.

WHERE: Volunteers are needed to count in designated areas throughout Lebanon County.

WHY: Information collected from the count and survey is required to continue receiving funding for homeless programs, to develop strategies to end homelessness, and to help homeless children and families who are in need.
