- Clinical Support
 - Registered Nurse
 - Medical Assistant
- Certified Community Health Worker



Overview

- Started April 2021 to address community access to COVID-19 Vaccinations and Testing
- Spring 2022 – pivot to mobile medicine
- Community Partners – LifePath, Bell Socialization Services, Changing Lives Shelter, New Hope Ministries (Hanover), Affordable Housing Advocates, White Rose Senior Center, Windy Hill Senior Center, and more!
- CHW Partnerships – Penn State York



Program Data

- **COVID-19 Vaccinations**
 - 102 community events
 - 1,276 total vaccinated in community
- **COVID-19 Testing**
 - 137 community events
 - 2,817 total tested; 23% positivity rate
- **Influenza**
 - Over 60 community members vaccinated
- **Blood Pressure Checks**
 - Since June 1, 2022, 2,103 blood pressure checks completed
 - Senior Centers, Affordable Housing, Shelters, and more to come!



LifePath Christian Ministries

- Spring 2022: Focus groups with Guest and Staff
- Pilot Launched September 2022
- Onsite services provided
 - New Patient Registration
 - Internal and External Referrals
 - Medication review and education
 - Health Screenings
 - Insurance Needs / Sliding Fee Scale
 - RHIV Testing
- Since September 2022 – 380 Unique Guests, 921 services provided
- Linked to Care – 84 Unique Guests attended 245 office visits (medical, dental, optometry, etc.)
- “Considering that transportation is an issue,” says a guest at the women’s shelter, “having them come here is a great asset. I’m very grateful for that.”



Bell Socialization Services

- Partnership began June 2024
- Replicate model of LifePath Partnership
- Weekly on-site presence
- Guest encounters – 81
- Linked to Care – 21
- Telehealth Pilot Program



Certified Community Health Worker

- Presence at Step into Life, LCCM, food pantries, and community events.
- First Medical site to become a food distribution with Power Packs in Lebanon
- Performcare Grant- Assist FFH patients that are MA recipients with SDOH needs
- 1:1 with patients and community members to address needs such as food, financial, housing, medication, appointments, and overall community resources



Next Phase

- **Community Healthcare**
 - Increase health screenings offered onsite utilizing RN
 - DM Foot Checks
 - Continue to address barriers to care, including health insurance
 - Onsite / telehealth provider appointments
