
## WIC Works!





#### What are our Goals?

Increase WIC and Head Start coenrollment by

Current co-enrollment is 70.6%. To meet our goal, co-enrollment needs to reach 89%

Increase overall WIC participation in Lebanon County by

# Pop-up Clinics & Point-of-Care Testing

Point-of-care pop-up clinics break down barriers to care by meeting people where they are. By bringing timely testing and treatment to underserved individuals within our community, these clinics build trust, reduce disparities, and advance health equity.





#### **Lab Based Testing**

Traditional testing that requires a urine and a blood sample.


Must be sent out to a lab and can take several days to get results to patient.

#### **Point-of-Care Testing**

Utilizes a finger stick blood draw with a lancet.

Results received within 10-20 minutes depending on test.

Tests for HIV, Syphilis, and Hepatitis C



The kiosk is available to anyone within the community who wishes to utilize its services. A user does not have to be a patient here.
